

# Adam and Eve

## SLIDE 1 Adam and Eve

*Genesis is the book of beginnings. It tells us where we came from, why we are here and what we are to do.*

## SLIDE 2 God creates man and woman

God created everything seen and unseen. The heavens and the earth, stars, sky, water, animals then Adam and Eve in paradise, with no sin and they had a relationship with God.

We were created to have a relationship with God. Until we do it's like having a God shaped hole in our heart. Until you let God fill that hole in your heart you will try to fill it with other things but they won't satisfy.

God created Adam from the dust of the earth and breathed life into him.

God put Adam into the Garden of Eden and told him not to eat of any tree except the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, if you eat of it you shall surely die.

God brought the animals to Adam to see what he would call them.

There was no suitable helper there for him and God saw it was not good for man to be alone so God made woman as a companion to work together.

The God put Adam into a deep sleep and took a rib from Adam and formed Eve.

Joke - that's probably why men are so dumb, the Bible never says God woke him up. That's why woman are so strong, they're made from bone - LOL

God brought the woman to Adam, they were both naked and when Adam saw Eve naked he called her wooooo-man (because he saw her naked haha).

He named her Eve (Living) for she would be the mother of all living.

## SLIDE 3 God created marriage:

He created them in His image, He created them male and female.

Gen 2:24-25 This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one. Now the man and his wife were both naked, but

they felt no shame.

- Guilt and shame come from sin and there was no sin and no death at this time.
- God told them to be fruitful and multiply.

#### **SLIDE 4 Satan tempts Eve**

The serpent was the most cunning of creatures. Did God really say you could not eat of any tree in the garden?

- Satan embodied himself in the form of a snake.
- Satan likes to deal in extremes
- Eve said no just the one tree, and if we eat of it we will die.
- Satan said you will not die, you will become like God and know good and evil.
- Satan tells lies and likes to cast doubt on God's character and word.

#### **SLIDE 5 The fall of mankind (what it is referred to as when sin entered the world)**

Eve saw the tree was good for food and pleasant to the eyes so she ate the fruit and gave it to her husband Adam and he ate it also.

Their eyes were opened and they both saw they were naked and they sewed fig leaves together to cover their nakedness.

They heard the sound of the Lord coming and they hid themselves.

God said where are you Adam?

I heard your voice and was afraid because I was naked so I hid myself.

Who told you that you are naked? Did you eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil?

Adam blamed Eve, Eve blamed the serpent.

#### **SLIDE 6 Consequences of sin - a curse**

**Snake-** walk on it's belly and eat dust and from the woman give birth to Jesus to step on your head, or be victorious over Satan via the cross, death and resurrection.

#### **Woman**

**Genesis 3:16** Then He said to the woman, "I will sharpen the pain of your pregnancy, and in pain you will give birth. And you will desire to control your husband, but he will rule over you."

#### **Man**

Genesis 3:17-19.....Ground is cursed because of you. All your life you will struggle to scratch a living from it. It will grow thorns and thistles for you, though you will eat of its grains. By the sweat of your brow will you have food to eat until you return to the ground from which you were made. For you were made from dust, and to dust you will return."

- God banished them from the garden- Jesus will one day restore everything back to paradise (heaven) for those who believe.
- God made skins to cover their nakedness. Something had to die to cover their

shame. God offers to cover your sin also through Jesus.

### **SLIDE 7 Apply**

God created everything so He gets to make the rules. If you obey God your life will be satisfying.

Satan got Eve to question God's Word and character - never question God's Word or doubt His character, it will always end up in disaster. Trust God and His Word!

God will judge sin.

There are consequences to sin - so flee temptation, look for the way out.

There is hope; let God cover your sin too so you can have a relationship with God also.

### **Gospel- Would you let Jesus cover your sin today?**

**Romans 5:19** Because one person disobeyed God, many became sinners. But because one other person obeyed God(Jesus), many will be made righteous.

**Romans 5:21** So just as sin ruled over all people and brought them to death, now God's wonderful grace rules instead, giving us right standing with God and resulting in eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Cross - Jesus took your sin upon Himself

Died - Jesus paid the penalty of death for you.

Rose from the dead - victory over sin and death

To be saved you must

1. Realize you have sinned also, lied, stolen, lusted
2. Believe that Jesus paid the penalty for your sin on that cross.
3. Repent - change your mind about your sin and agree with God that sin is wrong.

Are you ready to get right with God, realize you have sinned, believe that Jesus died in your place and took your penalty upon Himself? Are you ready to repent, change your mind about your sin and agree with God it is wrong and receive Him today as your Savior.
